# REPORT ON THE INTER-COUNTY EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR WOMEN, YOUTH AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITY FROM THE COUNTIES OF NANDI, KIRINYAGA, BOMET AND KITUI HELD FROM 26<sup>TH</sup> TO 29<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2019 IN WOTE, MAKUENI COUNTY.



The Council of governors has been implementing the FORD Foundation Project titled 'Strenghtening the capacity of women- and youth-led counties for improved public participation in budgeting process and oversight of public resources in Kenya', aimed at facilitating effective coordination and ensure the select counties; Bomet, Kitui, Kirinyaga and Nandi, implement policies and laws that guarantee inclusion and meaningful participation of women, youth and PWDs in in budgeting processes to ensure public resource work for public good.
